ALADDIN KIDS

Aladdin Kids, our junior show, is a kid's version of Aladdin licenced by Music Theatre International. It is based on the iconic Disney animated film, the recent live action film, and the Broadway musical.

CAMP ROCK, THE MUSICAL

Camp Rock, The Musical our senior show is based on The Camp Rock movies Part 1 and Part 2 which starred Demi Lovato and The Jonas Brothers. Camp Rock, The Musical is a 90 minute one-act show and is also licensed by Music Theatre International.

For performers age 10-18

Rehearsals-

7th-12th of April 9:30am – 5:00 pm

13th is a half day of rehearsal.

13th of April early evening show time to be advised.

14th of April is a matinee and an early evening show.

Audition Instructions:

1. Video intro (Compulsory)

Please start your video off with the following slate..

*Name

*Age

*Which show you're auditioning for (If you are aged 10-12 please specify if you are interested in being considered for both shows or just one)

*Which role or roles are your preference (Please note that performers will be considered for all roles.)

*Tell us about your experience on stage and some interesting things about you so we can get to know you a little better. Please note that we need people with all different skills that can be used on stage, so make sure you tell us about these skills in your video.

All auditionees must submit an introductory video. If you would prefer to audition only for the ensemble and small roles, then this is the only video you are required to send in.

2. Song (optional)

If you would like to be considered for a solo singing/featured singing role then please also film a video of you singing a short excerpt (no more than 30 seconds) from a song that showcases your voice. You should sing something in the same style of the show that you are auditioning for and something that showcase your voice.

You can use live accompaniment or a backing track. If you don't have a backing track available, then please use a YouTube karaoke track. Do not sing with a vocal track or acapella, we want to hear your voice!

3. Acting/Dancing (Optional)

If you are not auditioning as a solo singer, then you are welcome to perform a short monologue and/or show us some of your dance

skills. Please note that these videos are also optional, you will still be considered for roles in the show if you don't submit acting or dance videos.

Send in the links.

Please make sure that your video is clear with good lighting and good sound. Also, make sure it's filmed in landscape. Once you have completed your audition video, please upload it to YouTube as an "unlisted video" and email us the link.

melbournekidstheatre@gmail.com Please make sure that your video is "unlisted" but not "private." If it's "private" we won't be able to view it. No video files can be accepted, link only.

Once the auditions have all been received you might be asked to send us some extra material because we need to see a little more from you. If you aren't asked to send more material in, it does not mean that you aren't being considered for a role in the show, it just means we have all the information we require from you.

Some important things to note....

If you have filled in the "expressions of interest" form all you need to do is email us your video link. If you have not done so then please follow the link below so that we know to expect your audition links.

Roles will be allocated shortly after the audition video submission date cut off on March 10th. Some performers will be asked to submit extra call back material. The casting decisions are final and made by the creative team. Casting outcomes cannot be challenged or discussed with the creative team. Whilst the casting process is competitive, Melbourne Kids Theatre has an all-inclusive policy. Performers of all levels and abilities are welcome to perform in our shows. We also aim to maximise each performer's stage time and ensure that everyone has a moment to shine on stage.

The auditions are to determine where the performer will get placed in the show. Show and program fees can be paid immediately to take advantage of the early bird rate and to confirm your place in the show (numbers are limited). Your place in the show is not confirmed until the payment has been made.

Rehearsals will take place at a studio in St Martins Anglican church South Yarra and shows will take place at The Skydeck Theatre in The Space Dance and Arts, Prahran. By enrolling in the show performers commit to all rehearsals and production dates as required.

Costumes for Camp Rock... As this is a modern show with teen characters, performers will need to provide some costume items such as black clothing, shoes and daytime casual wear. Performers will be informed of their requirements once their role has been allocated. Everyone will receive a Camp Rock or Camp Star show shirt that will also become part of their costume. Costumes for Aladdin Kids... costumes will be provided in the style of the show. Performers will need to provide some costume items such as black clothing and their own shoes. Performers will be informed of their requirements once their role has been allocated. Or performers will receive an Aladdin kids T-shirt this however will not be part of their Costumes.

By being involved in the production, you give Melbourne Kids Theatre permission to take photographs and videos during the rehearsals and the run of the show. These can be used for promotional purposes, on social media, and shared with cast members and their families.
